Ask your property manager to contact Republic Services about additional recycling, organic or landfill carts or bins, computer and TV collection, special clean ups or to request motor oil recycling kits, recycling tote bags and kitchen food scrap containers.

MORE ABOUT PLASTIC

After 2-3 cycles, the plastic is too brittle to work with and becomes trash. Even with huge companies like Starbucks working to include more recycled content, drink containers have maxed out at 2-3% postconsumer plastic*. But with a new California law signed Sept. 24, plastic bottles must contain 15% recycled plastic by 2022, 25% by 2025, and 50% recycled plastic by 2030.
