WASTE REDUCTION STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

A scholarship of up to \$4,000 will be awarded to up to four high school seniors per year by RecycleSmart. Once you are enrolled a check will be written to the college or university of your choice. All scholarship winners will be acknowledged by the RecycleSmart Board of Directors. To receive a scholarship student must attend the May 24, 2018 RecycleSmart Board meeting located at 1666 N. INSTRUCTIONS

Who is eligible?

1. Applicants must be enrolled as a senior of a public high school located within the boundaries of the RecycleSmart service area. (Visit www.recyclesmart.org/schools for a list of eligible public schools)
2. Applicants must be enrolled as a high school senior expecting to graduate by June 2018.
3. Applicants must live within the boundaries of the RecycleSmart service area.
4. No family members of the RecycleSmart staff or Board Members are eligible to apply.
5. Applicants must plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university for the entire 2018/19 academic year.
6. Project application must be received by **Friday, April 6, 2018, no exceptions.**

DESCRIPTION OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROJECT OR LEADERSHIP ROLE

Any student who has carried out an environmental project and/or demonstrated a role as an environmental leader is encouraged to apply for the RecycleSmart Waste Reduction Student Scholarship. Write essay answers (note max. word count, double-spaced, 12-point Times New Roman font, and 1” margins) addressing each of the following topics:

- What does waste reduction mean to you and how has this experience developed your capacity to act as an environmental steward? (500-word maximum)
- Briefly describe your waste reduction project or your role as your school’s waste reduction leader and what inspired you to carry out this project or role. (200-word maximum) Also include a video that demonstrates the described project.
- Describe how you applied the tenets of the 4Rs: Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, and Rot to your project. (200-word maximum)
- Describe the results of your project or your leadership role: did your project result in waste reduction and/or an increased diversion rate at your school? (200-word maximum)
- In what ways has your project or leadership role increased waste reduction awareness within your school? (200-word maximum)
- Attachments – You may include up to two pages (8.5”x11”, double-sided) of attachments that support your project. Attachments can contain photos, illustrations, or additional information.
- Include information of school personnel (teacher, principal and advisor) that can verify implementation and success of project.
