

The Recycling Yard: How it works

Open Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to noon and 12:30 to 4:30 pm



- A** This is the entrance residents should use to access the the Recycle Yard off Rockview Drive.
- B** No resident access. Truck entrance gate for staff and GRF contractors only. Concrete, dirt and asphalt recycling.
- C** Box for household batteries only.
- D** Compost container for residents*
- *Attendant can provide compost bucket for home use.
- E** No resident access to landfill dumpsters. For staff or GRF contractors only.

- 1. Station 1:** flat, clean cardboard, packing paper and books.
- 2. Station 2:** mixed construction debris. This is not for contractors or residents doing remodels. That debris must be taken out of Rossmoor.
- 3. Station 3:** mixed construction debris, metal and wood, including furniture that does not contain fabric or plate glass.

- 4-5. Stations 4 and 5:** Wood only. Wood can contain nails but nothing else.
- 6, 7 and 8. Stations 6, 7 and 8:** Green landscaping waste used by staff and GRF contractors

† Vehicles should enter or back up to designated stations, not park parallel to them.

Additional guidelines

- When cones and chains are present, station is closed because it is full.
- Attendant cannot assist with unloading recyclables because of COVID rules. Masks are required.

Additional recycling resources

- Appliances and e-waste**
- Free pickup of electronics with cord or that ran on batteries, metals, tools, wire, cell phone, computer, keyboard, printer, television, monitor and vacuum cleaner.
 - Appliances (for fee); refrigerator, freezer and AC (\$42); washers, dryers, dishwashers, stoves and ovens (\$20); cooktops and water heaters (\$15); and microwaves (\$15).

- Service not applicable to Waterford residents but will pick up for reduced rate of \$40, plus any recycle fees.

- Flourescent light bulbs**
- Recycle at Ace Hardware, Home Depot and Lowes
- Reminder**
- No dumping allowed at clubhouses.
 - Entry dumpster or cart lids open even half an inch are billed to Mutual for overflow

What's not allowed

- Shiny paper
- Small plastic bags
- Lightbulbs
- Non-household batteries
- Bubble wrap
- Styrofoam
- Upholstered furniture
- Paint
- Hazardous materials
- Move-in, move-out waste
- E-waste
- Rocks
- Rugs or carpets
