

CCCSWA COLLECTION RFP ADDENDUM #3 JANUARY 8, 2025

SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLING ACCOUNT LIST

Republic has provided a list of single-family dwelling accounts by service area and container size.

Single-Family-Accounts

The list includes a row for each container at a service address. The site address is the service address.

Material Type

Column N lists the (material) Type for each container. The Type codes are as follows:

- CA = solid waste
- YC = commingled organics
- RC = recyclables

Container Size

Column O states the size of each container. The container sizes are in cubic yards. One cubic yard = 202 gallons.

- 0.10 = 20 gallons
- 0.17 = 32 gallons
- 0.32 = 64 gallons
- 0.48 = 96 gallons

On-Property Service

On-property service is collection from the backyard or sideyard of a single-family dwelling. Republic reports that 944 single-family customers currently have on-property service. Of the 944 single-family customers with on-property service, 460 of them pay extra for on-property service, while 484 receive on-property service at no additional charge due to disability.

The list provided by Republic only identifies the on-property customers who are paying extra for the service. Those customers are highlighted in the spreadsheet, and also have charge code (Column T) H75. Republic is working on a revised single-family account list that also identifies the 484 customers who receive disability on-property service at no additional cost. The Authority will provide the revised list to potential proposers via our webpage with email notification once the revised list is received.

Burro Routes

"Burro" trucks are smaller trucks used to collect from hard-to-serve areas. Column V indicates whether or not a container is on a route served by a Burro truck.

Hard-to-Serve Rates

A "U" in Column P, Stop Code, indicates that an account pays the hard-to-serve rates. Note that most accounts on Burro routes are not paying hard-to-serve rates.

Location Code

Column Q indicates the member agency in which an account is located. For the County, there are three Location Codes (County, Pleasanton, Tassajara) which correspond to the different rates in those three unincorporated areas.

Republic provided the current rate sheets as a "key" to the rate codes used in the single-family account list.

FOLLOW-UP ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS FROM POTENTIAL PROPOSERS

1) <u>Background information</u>-version file, Commercial MFD Account Data:

The tab lists service frequency as 0 for some of the accounts, what does that mean?

For the accounts with roll-off boxes and roll-off compactors, the "0" service frequency indicates on-call.

Below are explanations for the other accounts with "0" service frequency for containers under 10 cubic yards:

- 1375 Civic Dr (Civic Park, Walnut Creek) was for a one-time event donation. In addition to their regularly scheduled service.
- 300 Moraga Rd (Campolindo High School, Moraga) was for a one-time event donation. In addition to their regularly scheduled service.
- 3780 Mt. Diablo Blvd. (Lafayette War Veterans, Inc.) is on call at their request.
- 390 San Carlos Dr. (Heather Farms Equestrian) is on call because it is rarely used.

2) Request for Proposal, Page 11, 3.7. Notable Local Conditions:

"Rossmoor has a variety of collection service arrangements including single-family cart service, multi-family and commercial bin service, and drop box service."

As mentioned in the RFP, Rossmoor has single-family cart service, multi-family cart service, multi-family and commercial bin service, and drop box service, but the excel file "Background- Information-Version" lists Rossmoor account addresses in the Commercial MFD Account Data tab under the account type multi-family. Can you please confirm if all Rossmoor accounts are Multi-family?

There are 100+ homes in Rossmoor that receive single-family style individual cart service. These homes are included in the single-family dwelling account list submitted by Republic. There were not included in the Commercial MFD list.
